

A: What you have, as written, is something like this: pids = [] for i in ps aux | grep "process name" | grep -v grep | awk '{print \$2}' : pids.append(i) # These are now reversed pids = reversed(pids) if you want to do something to each of the elements, you can do this: for p in pids: # Do something with p here Or, you can do this: for p in reversed(pids): # Do something with p here

Dim columns As Integer = Application.WorksheetFunction.ColumnCount(Sheets(1).Range("A:A")) I'm then using it in a for loop which looks like this: For i = 1 To columns For j = 1 To columns ActiveSheet.Cells(1, i) = "something" Next j Next i If I run it with 'Application.WorksheetFunction.ColumnCount(Sheets(1).Range("A:A"))' it will run and only give me one column of data. If I run it with 'Columns.Count' it will work but it doesn't tell me how many columns it found, it just returns the total number of columns, all of which is the number of columns on the sheet. I'm pretty new to programming so any help or direction would be great. A: Try this: ActiveSheet.UsedRange.Columns.Count This will give you the number of columns that are occupied by data. A: The fastest way to get the column count is this: Application.WorksheetFunction.ColumnCount(ActiveSheet.UsedRange) Or, just as a method to get the last row/column, do this: ActiveSheet.UsedRange.Cells(ActiveSheet.UsedRange.Rows.Count + 1, ActiveSheet.UsedRange.Columns.Count + 1).Select Hope this helps. A: Check the WorkingSheets property of the ActiveWorkbook object, you will get all sheets in that workbook. Then you can access the Worksheets collection and get the active sheet. Dim columns As Integer columns = ActiveWorkbook.Worksheets(1).Columns.Count Or, to get the total columns, you can use the
